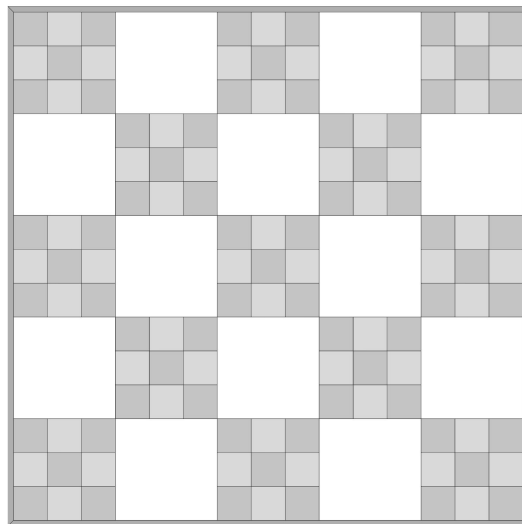


9 Patch Wonder

Finished quilt 37" x 37"



This is by far one of my favourite quilts to make. It is called a wonder because it is so straight forward, quick to put together and when people see that you created this, they are all going to wonder at how you were able to create such an incredible quilt!!

Materials (Shopping List)

Select 3 fabrics for this quilt. Please note that this quilt can be made with scraps also.

Fabric A: .7m or .8 yards

Fabric B: .5m or .5 yards

Fabric C: .5m or .5 yards

Binding Fabric: .25m or .3 yards

Backing Fabric: 1.2m or 1 ¼ yds

Batting: I recommend 80 cotton/ 20 polyester blend. 50 Inches square. 1.25 meters

Quilting supplies

Cutting mat (self healing min size 24" x 36"), rotary cutter (60mm), clear quilting ruler (6 inches by 30), iron and ironing board, spray basting or basting pins (min 50), scissors, measuring tape, pins (see recommended supplies on my website).

Cutting Instructions

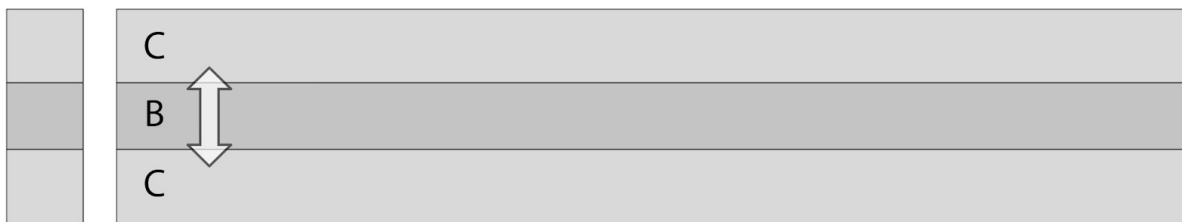
Cut Fabric A into 8" squares, you require 12. Cut 8 inches by WOF. Sub cut 4 squares from each strip or WOF. You will cut 3 strips in total

Fabric B: cut 3" by WOF. Cut 5. I like to trim the selvage edges off before cutting.

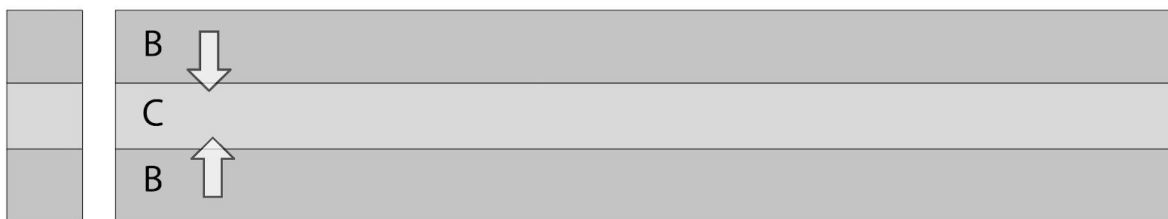
Fabric C: cut 3" inches by WOF. Cut 4.

Sewing Instructions

To create the first strip set CBC sew strip C to B. Now sew CB to C. It will look like the picture below. Press the seams facing the outside as indicated. Make one set.

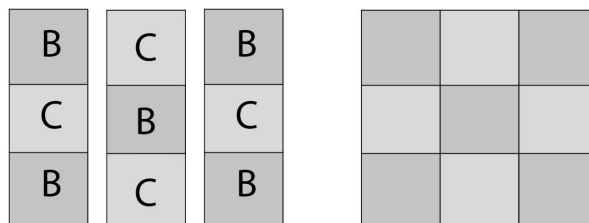


Now make the opposite sets: sew BCB make 2 sets. Press the seams towards the center.



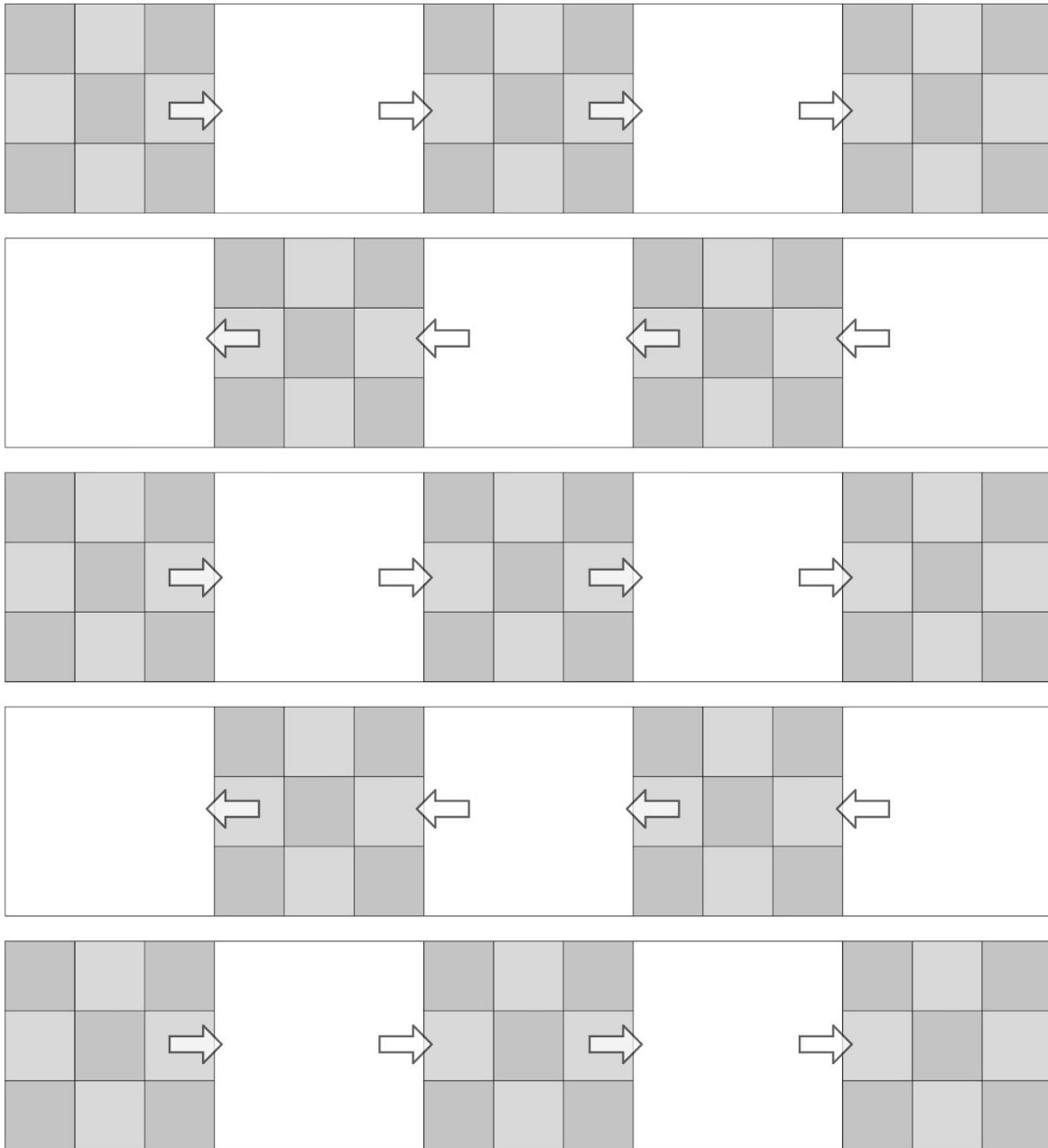
Sub cut the sets by 3 inches- each set will yield 13 sets.

Now to assemble the 9 patch blocks: take 2 BCB sets to one CBC set and sew them together making sure that they are alternating colour.



Squaring up the blocks before assembling them into the quilt top. Despite our best efforts to have perfectly square blocks we need to have our own backs. I love to use Lori Holt's Cute Cuts 10-inch square ruler to make sure that my pieced block is exactly 8 inches square.

See the diagram of the layout. Create as desired. If you check out my YouTube tutorial I show how I mark where each square needs to be placed and transferred over to your sewing machine.



Sew together one row at a time.

Rows 1,3,5 are the same and they start and end with the 9-patch blocks. Press to the right.

Alternately, rows 2 and 4 start and end with the 8-inch blocks. Press to the left.

Now that these are pressed this way, sew the rows together. The directional seams will be able to 'lock' together and the top will go together much more smoothly. Continue until all rows are sewn together. Press all the seams facing down.

The top is now complete!

The next step is to baste the top to the bottom with the batting in between. This is a perfect time to turn to the video instructions on this. I recommend that you practice on a quilt sandwich how to baste and how to do free motion quilting.
